This document is a template with instructions for formatting Extended Abstracts to submit to the 18<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Geometry and Graphics (ICGG 2018 Milano). We recommend authors to follow to the letter this layout, so that all papers in the proceedings will have a consistent appearance. Since this paper itself is formatted according to the formatting rules and contains preformatted styles, we strongly suggest authors *replace* the text of this file with their own text, without overriding any settings. Extended Abstracts prepared in  $\text{\LaTeX}$  must be formatted using the font Times New Roman, converted, and submitted in *pdf* format. Abstract must contain only abstract title, authors' names and their affiliations, abstract text, and three to six keywords, and no references have to be listed. No footnote marks have to appear in the title if there is only one affiliation. Select your option below, if this submission is for Full Paper or Poster presentation.
